

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ELLIOT LAKE

BY-LAW NO. 79-21

Being a by-law respecting motorized snow vehicles and to repeal By-law Nos. 70-4 and 79-17.

The Council of The Corporation of the Town of Elliot Lake ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Definitions:

For the purposes of this by-law:

- (a) "Boulevard" means all those parts of highway lying between the curb or edge of the roadway and the highway boundary, exclusive of the area covered by a sidewalk;
- (b) "Central Commercial Area" means that part of the Municipality bounded on the north by the southerly limit of Hillside Drive North, on the east by the westerly limit of the King's Highway Number 108, on the south by the northerly limit of Hillside Drive South and on the west by the westerly limit of Ontario Avenue and shall include all parts of Ontario Avenue;
- (c) "Corporation" means The Corporation of the Town of Elliot Lake;
- (d) "Council" means the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Elliot Lake;
- (e) "Highway" shall be as defined in the Highway Traffic Act of Ontario, R.S.O. 1970 and amendments thereto;
- (f) "Motorized Snow Vehicle" shall be as defined in the Motorized Snow Vehicle Act, R.S.O. 1968 and amendments thereto;
- (g) "Park or Parking" shall be as defined in the Highway Traffic Act of Ontario, R.S.O. 1970 and amendments thereto;
- (h) "Residential Areas" means those areas designated Residential "RI". "R1M", "R2" and "R2M" Zones as set out in Appendix "B" of By-law No. 56-13 and amendments thereto;
- (i) "Roadway" shall be as defined in the Highway Traffic Act of Ontario, R.S.O. 1970 and amendments thereto;
- (i) "Sidewalk" means any walkway designed exclusively for the use of pedestrians.

2. Prohibitions

(a) No person shall drive a motorized snow vehicle in any part of the Central Commercial Area, provided that this section shall not apply to:

(i) a motorized snow vehicle actually engaged in works undertaken by employees of the Corporation, Ontario Hydro, Bell Canada, Police Department, Fire Department, or others as designated by the Council, or

(ii) motorized snow vehicles being driven in conjunction with a parade or contest being held with the permission of the Chief of Police of the Corporation.

(b) No person shall drive a motorized snow vehicle along, across or upon any highway or part of a highway within any residential area in the Town of Elliot Lake between the hours of 11:00 o'clock in the afternoon and 7:00 o'clock in the forenoon of the next day following, provided, however, that this section shall not apply to motorized snow vehicles actually engaged in work by employees of the Corporation, Ontario Hydro, Bell Canada, Police Department, Fire Department, or others as designated by the Council.

(c) No person shall park a motorized snow vehicle upon any highway or part of a highway in the Central Commercial Area.

(d) No person shall park a motorized snow vehicle upon any sidewalk within the Municipality.

3. That By-law Nos. 70-4 and 79-17 are hereby repealed.

4. Penalty

Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$300.00 exclusive of costs.

READ a third time and finally passed this 14th day of February, 1979.
