You can now apply for an Affordable Access Card online at www.elliottlake.ca. Visit the main page and follow the link under "I Want To Apply" → "Affordable Access Card."

Application Requirements:

All applicants must submit:

- A completed application form.
- A 2024 Revenue Canada Notice of Assessment (including for dependents 18+) showing all income at line 15000.

Once reviewed, all Revenue Canada documents are securely destroyed.

Paper application forms are available at City Hall and the Elliot Lake Public Library.

Open to all residents and businesses. The City's Economic Development Dept. will be presenting current and ongoing initiatives with an opportunity for community members to provide feedback.

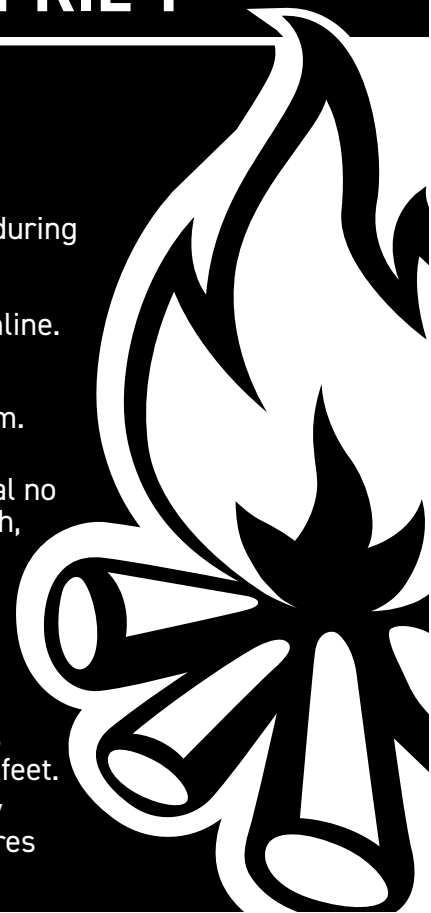
2025 FIRE SEASON BURNING PERMITS AVAILABLE APRIL 1ST

Starting April 1st, Elliot Lake residents can purchase their open air burning permits from the Fire Department for \$10.

Permits are required for all residents planning to have outdoor fires of any kind during the fire season (April 1 to October 31), and can be purchased in-person at the Fire Hall (55 Hillside Dr. North) or online.

Requirements of the permit include:

- Burning can only be conducted after 6 p.m. and before 10 a.m.
- In an urban setting, an amount of material no more than 2 ft. by 2 ft. as well as 2 ft. high, can be burned at one time.
- Burning any materials that are toxic or hazardous is prohibited.
- Burning is not permitted when wind speeds exceed 16 km/hr.
- In a rural setting, all land-clearing debris must be in piles separated by at least 15 feet.
- Fires must be at least three metres away from any buildings, hedges, overhead wires or other structures.

NO SMOKING OR VAPING IN PUBLIC



The City of Elliot Lake smoking by-law, by-law #21-49 regulates smoking or vaping in or around City owned property, City workplaces or City owned structures. For example places like the Fire Tower Lookout, Miner's Monument, City Hall, the Municipal pool, and ball fields all fall under by-law #21-49. This by-law is enforced by the Municipality proactively and on a complaint driven basis.

To report a smoking or vaping complaint on or near City owned property call the Elliot Lake By-law Enforcement team at 705-848-2287 ext. 2119 or alternatively by email at bylaw@elliottlake.ca.

The Smoke Free Ontario Act regulates smoking or vaping in or on private property and multi-residential settings. For example, locations such as malls, grocery stores, restaurants or condominium complexes. The Algoma Public Health Unit (APH) out of Sault Ste. Marie is responsible for the enforcement of The Smoke Free Ontario Act and will conduct proactive compliance activities and will also investigate incidents on a complaint driven basis.

To report a smoking or vaping infraction on private property such as malls, stores, restaurants or in a multi residential setting you can visit APH at; www.algomapublichealth.com or call 705-942-4646.
