- Choose shatterproof ornaments
- Use twist ties or string to secure decor
- Anchor your tree to the wall or ceiling
- Weigh down the tree base to stop tipping
- Keep real trees well watered
- Place bells on trees as an alert system
- Make a foil skirt to deter climbing pets
- Tape down extension cords

Dog - Spayed/neutered*	\$40.00
Dog - Not spayed/neutered	\$85.00
Cat - Spayed/neutered*	\$30.00
Cat - Not spayed/neutered	\$65.00

Transfer of License (no discount) \$5.00 +HST

* Note that, if City Hall can verify your pet has been spayed/neutered, you will receive a discount on your pet tag

You must have proof that your pet has been spayed or neutered to qualify for a reduced rate on pet tags, as well as proof of rabies vaccination. All dogs and cats in the Elliot lake area must be licensed and the tag must be attached to your dog or cat at all times.

As per By-law 22-100 the maximum number of pets per residence is 5; no more than 3 dogs or 3 cats.
