## NEW SWIMMING POOL BY-LAW IN EFFECT

As we head into another summer season, the City of Elliot Lake would like to inform residents that By-law No. 24-28 has been enacted to regulate all private swimming pools within the city.

Here are a few key highlights for property owners to consider:

**Definition:** A "swimming pool" is defined as any outdoor body of water contained by artificial means on privately owned property, where the depth of water at any point can exceed 0.6 metres. This includes any associated deck or support structure.

**Permits:** A permit is required to construct a swimming pool.

**Fencing:** All pools must be enclosed by a fence or other barrier with a minimum height of 1.5 metres.

**Gates:** Gates must be equipped

with self-closing, self-latching, and spring-loaded mechanisms, and must be kept locked.

**Water Quality:** Pool water must be maintained and not allowed to become stagnant.

**Zoning Compliance:** Some swimming pools may be subject to zoning setbacks and height requirements.

**Backflow Prevention:** A backflow preventer must be installed on water supply lines.

**Hot Tubs & Spas:** While hot tubs, whirlpools, and spas are exempt from fencing requirements, they must have a secure, lockable cover in place when not in use.

## WHEN ARE BUILDING PERMITS REQUIRED?

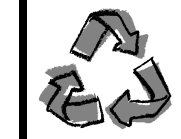
Did you know that some home projects require a building permit in Elliot Lake? Here are some examples:

- Decks, porches, steps, sunrooms, sheds, garages, and additions
- Creating additional dwelling units in a home/building
- Siding, soffit, fascia, and new roofing
- Signs
- Some retaining walls > 1m in height
- Temporary garages and large tents
- Weeping tile and foundation repair/replacement
- Swimming pools
- Fences
- Woodstove installations
- New plumbing work
- Sewer and water line repairs

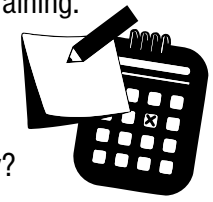
