Dog - Spayed/neutered*	<b>\$25.75</b>
Dog - Not spayed/neutered	<b>\$46.35</b>
Cat - Spayed/neutered*	<b>\$20.60</b>
Cat - Not spayed/neutered	<b>\$36.05</b>

Transfer of License (no discount) \$5.15 +HST

\* Note that, if City Hall can verify your pet has been spayed/neutered, you will receive a discount on your pet tag

You must have proof that your pet has been spayed or neutered to qualify for a reduced rate on pet tags, as well as proof of rabies vaccination. All dogs and cats in the Elliot lake area must be licensed and the tag must be attached to your dog or cat at all times.

As per By-law 22-100 the maximum number of pets per residence is 5; no more than 3 dogs or 3 cats.

As residents prepare for the fall and winter months ahead, the By-Law Office would like to remind everyone that tangible items such as basketball hoops, hockey nets, and any other items

should be removed from roadside and safely placed behind your front property line. Also, in order to facilitate and help our Public Works Department with snow removal we ask that people refrain from parking on City sidewalks and boulevards.

Come November 01 and running until March 31 we ask that citizens not park on streets between the hours of 12AM to 7AM from Nov 01 to March 31 in order to facilitate snow plowing and removal activities. Education and compliance is always a preferred outcome, but under Municipal By-Law, individuals could also be susceptible to fines and other penalties for noncompliance".

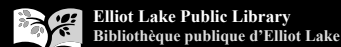

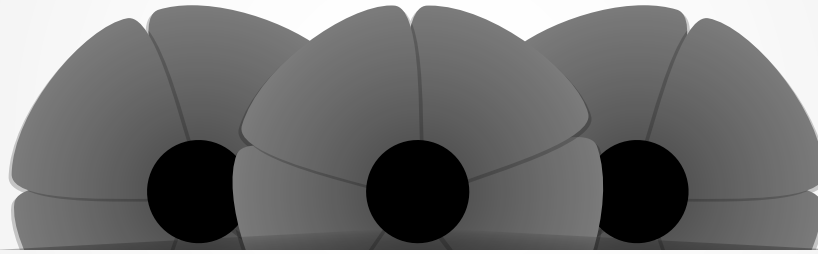
