PRIMARY PURPOSE OF JOB:	Crew leader in carrying out maintenance and repairs of roads, curbs, sidewalks and other municipal infrastructure. Performs repairs and maintenance of water and sewer works as required.

BASIC JOB DUTIES:

1. Leads a crew that carries out various maintenance and construction jobs as assigned by supervisor i.e. ditching, culvert repair or replacement, road repair, curb and sidewalk repair, decorative brick and block work etc.
2. Ensures the efficiency, quality, safety and productivity of each job assigned.
3. Provides knowledge, experience and leadership required to complete assigned jobs.
4. Completes Daily Activity Cards for assigned crew.
5. Reports to supervisor all field problems and deficiencies encountered while on duty and any problems related to conduct of assigned work crew.
6. Other related duties as may be assigned.
