Under the direction of the Manager of Recreation & Culture, the Lifeguard is responsible for the safety of patrons in the aquatic facility, whether on the deck or in the pool as well as on the beach or in the lake at municipal beach sites.

The preferred applicant will have:

- Minimum completion of Grade 12 or equivalent
- Minimum 6 months previous lifeguard experience preferred
- National Lifeguard Service – pool option certificate
- Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certificate
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR Level “C”, plus Automated External Defibrillator (AED) certification
- The ability to meet varied shift requirements, including weekend, statutory holidays, early morning and evening shifts
- Police Record Check – Vulnerable Sector Screening clearance
- Excellent demonstrated teamwork, communication and interpersonal skills
- Thorough knowledge of programs and services offered by the department
- Practices and maintain skills and updates certifications prior to their expiry dates
