To preserve, accurately record and promote the proud and diversely unique heritage of Elliot Lake, detailing the history of our early aboriginal inhabitants, our fur trappers and loggers, through the full circle of our Uranium Mining Industry from its origins to its state-of-the-art decommissioning. Our Museum also tells the story of our community's fight for survival against what was perceived as insurmountable odds, reflecting on the strength of our citizens, together with the foresight and ingenuity of our Community Leaders. Central to our exhibits is the Canadian Mining Hall of Fame, displaying portraits and biographies of individuals who have demonstrated outstanding lifetime achievements in the Mining Industry.
