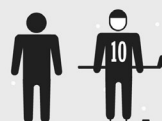

At least 10 cm (four inches) of clear blue ice is required to walk or skate on.

At least 20 cm (eight inches) for snowmobiles.

30 cm (twelve inches) or more is needed for most light vehicles.

Ice thickness should be doubled if the ice is white or opaque.
