## DID YOU KNOW?...

Feeding Wildlife By-Law 10-69 prohibits owners or occupiers of land within the City of Elliot Lake from intentionally feeding, cause to be fed or provide or make available food attractants or other similar substance for the consumption of Wildlife within the boundaries of the City of Elliot Lake, on either private or public property.

Bird feeders are exempt as long as you are only using bird feed. Bringing in your bird feeders at night will also keep the pests and wildlife away.

By-Law 21-23 and By-Law 21-14 require all property owners and occupants to keep their yards clean and tidy and all garbage stored appropriately.

Also, Bears and dogs don't mix. Keep your dogs on a non-retractable leash at all times when out and about. We all can do our part to avoid any unwanted bear encounters.



## CLERK'S CORNER

A commissioner for taking affidavits (also known as a Commissioner of Oaths) is a person authorized by the Province of Ontario to administer oaths or declarations when you sign an affidavit or statutory declaration. A Commissioner of Oaths does not certify that the statements being made in the affidavit or statutory declaration are true, but only certifies that an oath or solemn affirmation has been administered properly.

The Clerk's office provides a Commissioner of Oaths to sign documents such as affidavits at their discretion, that include but are not limited to:

- Family gift of a used vehicle
- Consent to travel with children (travel letters)
- Pension documents, Proof of Life forms and letters
- Legal name change forms

The Commissioner of Oaths will not sign documents that include but are not limited to:

- Wills
- Trusts and estate matters
- Codicils to wills
- Powers of attorney
- Real estate transactions
- Theft
- Custody/Support

Commissions are required to have an appointment. The cost is \$10 for one page or \$25 for multi-pages.

## A Message from the Elliot Lake Fire Department



## Building a Safe Campfire

Build campfires away from overhanging branches, steep slopes, rotten stumps, logs, dry grass, and leaves.

Keep the campfire small. A good bed of coals or a small fire surrounded by rocks gives plenty of heat. Use an existing fire ring.

Never leave a campfire unattended. Even a small breeze could quickly cause the fire to spread.

Start with dry twigs and small sticks. Remember, a good fire builder never needs gas or kerosene to start a fire.

Add large sticks as the fire builds up. Avoid using, hatchets, saws or breaking branches off dead tree. Dead and down wood burns easily.

Put the big pieces on last, pointing them toward the center, and pushing them into the flames. Use wood no larger than the diameter of an adult wrist.

## Putting out your campfire.

Keep plenty of water handy and have a shovel for throwing dirt on the fire if it gets out of control

Be sure your match is out cold. Break it so you can feel the charred portion before carefully discarding it.

Down the fire with water. Make sure all embers and sticks are wet. Move rocks, there may be burning embers underneath.

Stir the remains, add more water and stir again. Be sure all burned material has been put out and cooled. Smaller pieces of wood are easier to put out than large logs.

Feel all materials with your bare hand. Make sure that no roots are burning.

Campfires may be banned if wildfires are likely. Watch for signs and obey them.

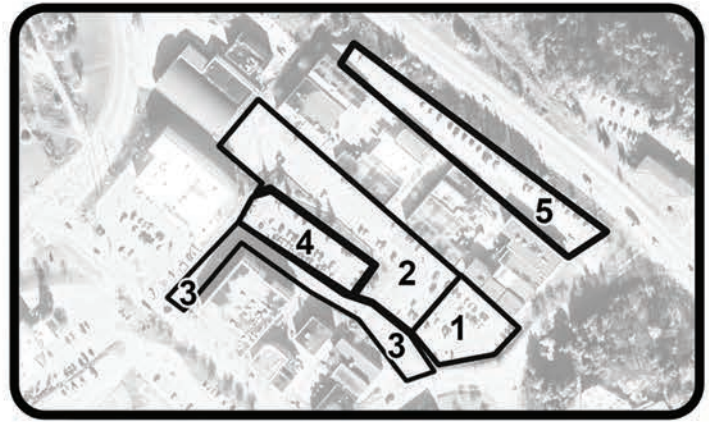
