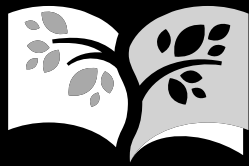

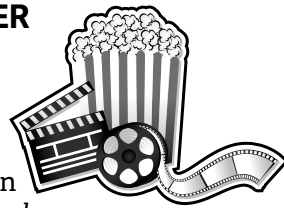

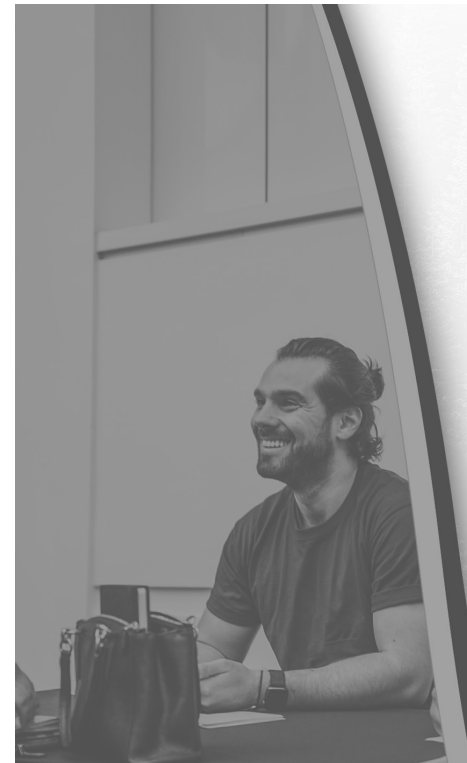

Did you know that there are certain rules and procedures for the public to attend Committee and Council Meetings? Certain protocols are expected of the public such as:

- Maintaining order and quiet;
- No engaging in conversation or behaviour that will disrupt the proceedings of Council or Committee;
- Drinks and food are not allowed;
- No use of insulting language or speaking disrespectfully towards the Royal Family, Governor General, Lt. Governor of any Province, any member of Federal or Provincial Government, any Member of Council, any employee of the City, or any individual;
- No person shall enter the Council Floor without the expressed permission of the Chair.

These rules and more can be found in Council's Procedural By-Law.
