Pet Tags ordered online will be mailed to the address provided *at no extra cost!*

YOU MUST HAVE PROOF THAT YOUR PET HAS BEEN SPAYED OR NEUTERED TO QUALIFY FOR A REDUCED RATE ON PET TAGS, AS WELL AS PROOF OF RABIES VACCINATION. ALL DOGS AND CATS IN THE ELLIOT LAKE AREA MUST BE LICENSED AND THE TAG MUST BE ATTACHED TO YOUR DOG OR CAT AT ALL TIMES.

As per By-law 22-100 the maximum number of pets per residence is 5; no more than 3 dogs or 3 cats.
