“ELLIOT LAKE FIRE DEPARTMENT RESTRICTS ALL OPEN AIR BURNING”

Elliot Lake, Ontario, July 14, 2026. Fire Chief John Thomas announced today that effective 10:00 a.m. July 14, 2026, due to no rain and extreme dry conditions, there is a Fire Ban in effect in Elliot Lake.

The Fire Ban means that **no burning or open flame** is allowed. This means:

- All burning permits are suspended.
- No campfires.
- No burning in outdoor fireplaces.
- No burning in outdoor fire pits.
- No incinerator burning.
- No brush or slash burning.

Any person setting an open air fire shall be responsible and liable for costs and could be liable to a fine.
